ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE:

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The Activities Committee develops and sponsors opportunities for the members of the community to gather and socialize. Examples include the December Holiday Party, Seasonal Food Truck visits and social time (with music or lawn games), and Museum Trips.

BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE:

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The Beautification Committee is responsible for the appearance of the Common Elements in our neighborhood. They usually meet during the cool morning hours to trim bushes and small trees, remove weeds, remove/replace plants that are not adding to the beauty of the Common Elements, and determine which decorative trees need replacement. They usually have a social time at the end of the season (as well as each time they meet).

GROUNDS COMMITTEE:

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The Grounds Committee is responsible for maintaining the community services, such as garbage collection, mowing, mulching, irrigation, snow removal, and tree trimming removal. In doing this the members of the committee gather information (and sometimes quotes) from vendors for these services. They inspect the premises for damage from the mowing and snow removal at the end of each season.
